Ingredients

Onions
Carrots, chopped
Coriander
Potatoes, chopped
Vegetable stock

Recipe of the Month: Carrot and Coriander Soup

Method

Sweat the onions in the pan
Add 1 tbsp. of coriander
Add the chopped carrots and then add the chopped potatoes
Cover the pan with boiled water, 1cm above
Add 1 tbsp. veg stock
Simmer mixture until soft and then blend
Season to taste.
