Recipe of the Month: Chicken curry

1 tbsp oil 1 onion finely chopped 2 garlic cloves chopped half tsp mild Chilli powder 1tsp ground coriander 1tsp ground cumin half tsp ground turmeric black pepper to taste 4 chicken breasts - cubed 100ml veg stock 1 tin chopped tomatoes 1 red pepper chopped 1 tbs tomato puree 1 diced carrot

Ingredients:

- Heat the oil and sauté the onion over a medium heat for about 8 minutes.
 - Add peppers and carrots.
- Add the garlic and all the spices and the tomato purée to the pan and stir for a minute or two until the spices are full of aroma.
- Add the chicken pieces and stir over the heat for a few minutes to colours.
- Add the stock and tomatoes, stir well, bring to simmer, and put lid on
- Cook for 20-30 minutes string occasionally until the chicken is cooked through and you see a rich sauce.
 - Serve with rice.
- Vegetarian option add a drained tin of chickpeas into the vegetables before frying.
